The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm. There were 32 club members, one new member, Terry Walls, and a guest, John Bennion (a knife maker), for a total of 34 present.

**Minutes** were approved.

**Treasurer's report:** Beginning balance of \$7004.57, Income \$694.00, Expenses \$940.60, for an ending balance of \$6757.97. The report was approved.

The **50/50 drawing** of \$18.50 was won by Marsha Middleton. The **door prize** of a plexiglas panel for a paint pallet and a piece of wood was won by Jane Sybauts.

**Election:** The nominating committee suggested President, Doug Bibles: Vice-President, John Heather: Secretary: Lyle Mankey, Treasurer, Judy McKinley, Board of Directors: Tom Lease (2 years), Vic Eckmann (1 year), Janice Riner (1 year), Bud Murray (1 year), Carol Murray (2 years), Rick Hartwig (1 year), Steve Hofstetter (2 years). The decision was made to go ahead and install these offices, to be effective January 2023. Motion was made and passed.

**Show report:** The club recognized some of the **outstanding helpers** in our Show: Pam Karl \$50 gift certificate, Pam Kasiske \$50, and Doug Bibles \$100. There was also a piece of wood donated to Doug. **The purpose of the Show** is to promote our club, sell tickets, promote our show, and encourage new carvers. There were 317 in attendance, down from over 400 last year. That was the only negative. We received good comments. We were understaffed for volunteers, but thanks to everyone who helped to make our show a success. Thanks to John Heather and Loren Woodard for **picking up wood** in Kansas City for our show. The **raffle project** sales are just over \$1,000, \$300 of that was sold at our show. The arm's length of tickets was a big success. The **attendance prize** of a beautiful flower carved by Bud Murray, painted by Doug Bibles, on a stand made by Doug Green was won by Cindy Marshall from Crocker, Mo. and she was delighted. **The 2023 show** will be October 21, 2023

The Festival season is over. There is a **Christmas Festival** the first December 7, and a Christmas on the Square coming up.

The next two classes for our beginners and intermediate **classes** that are normally held at the LCTC will be held at the Community of Christ Church at 42 Sunset Drive, Camdenton

**Christmas Dinner:** The club will furnish pulled pork. There will be a sign-up sheet at the November meeting. Members will furnish side dishes and dessert.
